Sealed tenders, plainly marked as to contents, will be received by the office of the Regional Clerk, The Regional Municipality of Niagara, 2201 St. David's Road, Thorold, Ontario, until 2 pm local time on

Tuesday, February 7, 2012

The work to be carried out under this contract consists of, but is not limited to:

- **Construct New BPS #3 including installation of three new domestic booster pumps and one new fire booster pump, electrical and SCADA appurtenances.**
- **Upgrade underground utilities to suit the new expansion.**
- **Disconnect of existing system and reconnection of proposed system under restricted hours and conditions.**
- **Upgrade other associated utilities, site piping, drainage, security and communication systems and landscaping.**
- **Demolish existing Booster Pumping Station #3 and existing generator building.**

A **non-mandatory** site visit has been scheduled for bidders at **10 am on Tuesday, January 24, 2012 at the Hixon Street Reservoir site**. Although the site visit is non-mandatory, bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.

This contract utilizes the “**Niagara Peninsula Standard Contract Document**” (**Revision 12**) which forms the specification documents excepting the “Special Instruction to Bidders, Form of Tender, and Supplementary Special Provisions”. The “Standard Document” is available on the internet at the “Tenders” section of the Niagara Region website (www.niagararegion.ca).

Plans, Specifications, and Form of Tender may be obtained from the Regional Office in the Public Works Department, 2201 St. David's Road Thorold, Ontario. A non-refundable payment in the amount of **\$150**, reflecting part of the cost of document preparation, will be required for each set of tender documents taken. Tender documents will be available for pick up on **Monday, January 16, 2012**. Plans and specifications may be viewed without charge, but not removed, at the major construction association offices.

All tenders must be accompanied by a tender deposit in the amount of **\$50,000**.

Tenders will be publicly opened at 2:15 pm at 2201 St. David's Road, Thorold. The lowest or any tender not necessarily accepted.
