- 5,000 t Granular Materials
- 14,000 m² Asphalt Milling
- 6,400 t Hot Mix Asphalt
- 1,300 m Curb and Gutter
- 2,500 m² Sidewalk
- Traffic Signal
- 17 Decorative Street light poles

This contract utilizes the "**Niagara Peninsula Standard Contract Document**" (**Revision 12**) which forms the specification documents excepting the "Special Instruction to Bidders, Form of Tender and Supplementary Special Provisions".
