First Technical Exchange Mission

Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program

Hanoi and Tuy Hoa, Viet Nam

November 11 to 27, 2004

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

The goals of the Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program are to increase the capacity of Tuy Hoa staff to address environmental/waste management challenges at the local level, and to create a clean and healthy physical environment for the people of Tuy Hoa.

The area of cooperation for the Regional Niagara - Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program will be waste management. The partnership program will focus on two waste management initiatives; waste collection and diversion, and waste disposal. The objectives of the partnership program are to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of Tuy Hoa's waste collection and diversion service, to ensure that Tuy Hoa's new waste disposal site is properly designed, managed, and operated, and to ensure that the existing waste disposal sites are properly closed and maintained. These objectives will be achieved by developing new waste management/environmental tools, systems, and procedures for Tuy Hoa.

The following are the area of cooperation activities:

- i. improve the waste collection and diversion service;
- ii. peer review the new waste disposal site design;
- iii. prepare the Landfill Closure Plan for the existing waste disposal sites; and
- iv. prepare the Landfill Operations and Maintenance Manual for the new waste disposal site.

1.2 Mission Purpose

The purpose of the First Technical Exchange Mission was to provide technical expertise and exchange information on:

- i. the design, operation, maintenance and closure of waste disposal sites; and
- ii. public consultation and identification of stakeholders and how these initiatives can be integrated into the work plans of the area of cooperation activities.

1.3 Mission Objectives

The following were the mission objectives of the First Technical Exchange Mission:

- i. Regional Niagara and Tuy Hoa to organize and conduct a one day workshop to discuss design considerations for new waste disposal sites. Representatives from other municipalities, provincial and national government departments and local engineer, retained by Tuy Hoa, to be invited to the workshop;
- ii. Regional Niagara and Tuy Hoa to have a working session to discuss the need for public consultation and how public consultation can be carried out with respect to the area of cooperation activities;
- iii. Regional Niagara and Tuy Hoa to visit Vietnamese municipalities who have properly closed their old waste disposal sites and tour sites; and
- iv. Regional Niagara and Tuy Hoa to visit Vietnamese municipalities who have prepared and implemented Landfill Operations and Maintenance Manuals and tour sites.

1.4 Expected Mission Results

The following were the expected mission results of the First Technical Exchange Mission:

- i. Design Considerations for New Waste Disposal Sites Workshop

It was expected that there would be a detailed discussion of design considerations for new waste disposal sites in Viet Nam at a workshop attended by Regional Niagara, Tuy Hoa, representatives

from other municipalities, provincial and national government departments and other invited stakeholders. Follow-up to the workshop discussions were to include the identification of common design considerations, the identification of unique design considerations for the new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site, a discussion on the *Check List of Information Relative to Design of New Waste Disposal Sites*, and a review of the preliminary design of the new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site.

ii. Public Consultation Working Session

It was expected that there would be candid discussions with all stakeholders on the need for public consultation and how public consultation can be carried out with respect to the area of cooperation activities. The working session discussions were to include: what is public consultation and its importance; common Canadian and Regional Niagara public consultation initiatives; identification of stakeholders/parties; Regional Niagara case studies; possible public consultation initiatives for Tuy Hoa; identification of stakeholders for the new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site; and preliminary planning for a consultation session for Tuy Hoa with stakeholders to provide input into design considerations of the new waste disposal site.

iii. Study Tour

It was expected that a study tour would be organized to two or three Vietnamese municipalities who are properly operating and maintaining existing waste disposal sites and have properly closed old waste disposal site(s). It was also expected that the municipalities being visited during the study tour would have prepared a Landfill Operations and Maintenance Manual and would provide this information to Tuy Hoa and Regional Niagara.

1.5 Mission Activities

At the beginning of the First Technical Exchange Mission, meetings were held in Hanoi with the Association of Cities of Viet Nam (ACVN) and the Belgian Technical Cooperation (BTC).

The Belgian Technical Cooperation is an implementing agency which carries out development projects in cooperation with partners in developing nations on behalf of the Belgian government and other donors. The BTC is working with the Viet Nam National Ministry of Planning and Investment to provide a donation of 3.3 million euros to improve the waste management system in the

Town of Tuy Hoa (e.g. construct the new waste disposal site, close the two existing Binh Kien and Phu Lam waste disposal sites, and improve the waste collection equipment).

Meetings were held with the Town of Tuy Hoa People's Committee:

- i. to obtain approval from the People's Committee on the draft Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program Project Proposal;
- ii. to discuss the BTC Project Proposal and implications on the Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program (e.g. integrate the two projects and minimize any duplication of work);
- iii. to provide information about Canadian and Niagara public consultation initiatives, and to identify and discuss potential public consultation initiatives for the Town of Tuy Hoa; and
- iv. for the People's Committee to elaborate on Tuy Hoa's waste management needs as detailed in the list of questions prepared by the Regional Niagara Delegation.

Meetings were held with the Town of Tuy Hoa Company of House Development and Municipal Construction (CHDMC) to discuss observations/findings from the study tour to the City of Thai Nguyen, the design considerations for the new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site, and the closure of the existing Binh Kien waste disposal site.

A meeting was held with the Town of Tuy Hoa Women's Union and the Town of Tuy Hoa Youth Union to provide an opportunity to present the draft Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program Project Proposal and the First Technical Exchange Mission Plan, and solicit input from the two organizations.

A meeting was held with the Headmaster and Grade 9 students of Truong THCS Tran Quoc Toan Secondary School in Tuy Hoa to provide an opportunity to present the draft Project Proposal and solicit input, and to discuss the proposed school partnership program between the school and St. Anthony School in St. Catharines, Ontario.

A study tour was made to the City of Thai Nguyen to learn about their waste management system and to tour their existing waste

disposal site. Site visits were made to the location of the proposed new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site, and the existing Binh Kien waste disposal site in Tuy Hoa.

2. MISSION RESULTS

The following are the results of the First Technical Exchange Mission:

- i. Three meetings were held between the Regional Niagara Delegation and the Town of Tuy Hoa CHDMC staff to discuss design considerations for new waste disposal sites. A site visit was made to the location of the proposed new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site and to the existing Binh Kien waste disposal site. The meetings and site visit provided excellent opportunities to exchange information and have detailed technical discussions at the staff-to-staff level. There were discussions about common design considerations, unique design considerations for the new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site, the *Check List of Information Relative to Design of New Waste Disposal Sites*, and a review of the preliminary design of the new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site. There were no representatives from other municipalities, or provincial and national government departments in attendance at the meetings. Regional Niagara provided engineering drawings of the design of the Niagara Road 12 Landfill Site in Niagara to the Tuy Hoa technical staff.
- ii. A working session was held between the Regional Niagara Delegation and the Town of Tuy Hoa People's Committee to discuss the need for public consultation and how public consultation can be carried out with respect to the area of cooperation activities. The working session discussions included a discussion on the types of public consultation and its importance; common Canadian and Regional Niagara public consultation initiatives, identification of stakeholders/parties, Regional Niagara case studies, and current and potential public consultation initiatives for the Town of Tuy Hoa. This forum provided a good opportunity to exchange information and included a question and answer session for both partner municipalities. Because of time and scheduling constraints, there was no discussions on the identification of stakeholders for the new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site, or preliminary planning for a consultation session for Tuy Hoa with stakeholders to provide input into design considerations of the proposed new waste disposal site.

- iii. A one day study tour was organized to visit one municipality, the City of Thai Nguyen, located approximately forty kilometres north of Hanoi. The Regional Niagara Delegation was accompanied by Dr. Vinh, Vice – General Secretary, Chief of ACVN Office, Louis Carpentier, Intern – Asia Program – FCM, (Mr.) Huynh Manh Hung, Vice – Director of CHDMC, and (Mr.) Hong Phu Nghiem, Interpreter/Translator for the Town of Tuy Hoa. The City of Thai Nguyen staff made a presentation about their waste management system which was followed by a site visit to their existing waste disposal site. No written information was provided during the meeting and it was difficult to gain an understanding of their system. The Regional Niagara Delegation was not able to determine if the municipality had a Landfill Operations and Maintenance Manual. The waste disposal site appeared to have some significant design and construction flaws (e.g. liner was slipping down the side slopes, potentially poor quality discharge from leachate treatment lagoon, periodic flooding of the leachate treatment facility, lack of proper stormwater management works, and lack of monitoring wells). The Regional Niagara Delegation did not visit their closed waste disposal site(s) and was unable to determine whether the City of Thai Nguyen had properly closed any old waste disposal sites.
- iv. There was much discussion during the First Technical Exchange Mission about the proposed project between the Belgium Technical Cooperation and the Viet Nam National Government on behalf of the Town of Tuy Hoa. Although Regional Niagara has not had an opportunity to review the Project Proposal or the Technical and Financial Assessment of the BTC project, Regional Niagara recognizes the need for capital investment in the waste management system for the Town of Tuy Hoa. The Town of Tuy Hoa People’s Committee supports the Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program and have indicated that there is no duplication of work between the two projects. It is recognised that there is significant benefit to the Town of Tuy Hoa to have a partner, Regional Niagara, providing “soft services” to the municipality while “hard services” are provided by BTC. Regional Niagara acknowledges that there is a need to coordinate the support and ensure that there is good coordination and cooperation between the two projects.
- v. During the mission, the Town of Tuy Hoa People’s Committee requested that the Regional Niagara Delegation prepare a list of questions for the committee about waste management/ environmental issues in the Town of Tuy Hoa, the draft Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program Project

Proposal, and any other related issues. The questions and the answers provided by the Town of Tuy Hoa People's Committee are attached as Appendix A of the Mission Plan.

- vi. During the course of the First Technical Exchange Mission, there were several changes to the mission schedule. The revised mission schedule is attached as Appendix B of the Mission Plan.

3.0 MISSION RECOMMENDATIONS

To enhance the value of the technical exchanges missions, it is important that partner municipalities maximize their opportunities to address the mission objectives with less time devoted to scheduling and mission logistics.

It is important that mission plans be prepared well in advance of the actual mission dates to ensure that both partner municipalities agree that:

- a. the mission schedule is reasonable and achievable;
- b. adequate time is allocated for each mission activity; and
- c. preparatory work is completed prior to the mission.

Now that the Town of Tuy Hoa has appointed the Project Coordinator and the Interpreter/Translator for this project, this should be less of a concern for future missions. In addition, each mission should include a Wrap-Up Meeting to identify follow-up activities and the schedule for the preparation of the next mission plan. For example, at the First Technical Exchange Wrap-Up Meeting, David Smith advised that he will prepare and forward the draft Second Technical Exchange Mission Plan to the Town of Tuy Hoa for their review and approval by the end of January 2005 subject to the review and approval of the document by FCM.

4. MISSION FOLLOW-UP

The following follow-up actions need to be undertaken as soon as possible (before the end of February 2005) to complete the objectives of the First Technical Exchange Mission:

- i. Regional Municipality of Niagara Responsibility

The Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipality Partnership Program Project Proposal needs to be approved by Regional Niagara Council. The staff report recommending approval is scheduled to be considered by Council at their meeting on February 3, 2005.

Regional Niagara needs to provide the Town of Tuy Hoa with information on Regional Niagara's waste management costs including waste collection, diversion and disposal as well as the monthly or annual waste management cost per resident.

Regional Niagara needs to provide the Town of Tuy Hoa with comparative costs of waste disposal site liner systems.

The following actions relate to the Partnership Support Activities:

Liaise with Local Council of Women (Niagara Chapter) to identify the contact person to establish a partnership between this organization and the Town of Tuy Hoa's Women's Union.

Advise staff from St. Anthony School in St. Catharines that the contact person at Truong THCS Tran Quoc Toan Secondary School is Nguyen Khoa Viet, School Headmaster, for the school partnership program. (The meeting with the principal of St. Anthony School was held on September 12, 2005.)

ii. Town of Tuy Hoa Responsibility

The Town of Tuy Hoa needs to provide Regional Niagara with a copy of the City of Thai Nguyen waste management system information which was provided to the Town of Tuy Hoa during the study tour.

iii. The Federation of Canadian Municipalities

The Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) needs to provide Regional Niagara with detailed information about the BTC Project with the Town of Tuy Hoa.

**5. RESULTS FROM PREVIOUS ACTIVITIES
(POST FIRST TECHNICAL EXCHANGE MISSION ACTIVITIES)**

The following activities have been undertaken since the First Technical Exchange Mission and have not been reported to date:

- i. A meeting was held on January 20, 2005 between David Smith and Professor Virginia W. Maclaren, Associate Professor at the University of Toronto who is the Canadian Director of the Waste-

Econ Program. The Waste-Econ Program is a six year collaborate program funded by the Canadian International Development Agency. The program is administered through the Department of Geography and the Institute for Environmental Studies at the University of Toronto as well as a number of government institutions, universities, and non-governmental institutions in Viet Nam, Laos and Cambodia. The aim of the project is to explore methods for recycling, exchanging and reducing waste in a way that will be beneficial to the economies of the partner countries, the people working in the waste management sector, and the environment as a whole. A number of pilot projects and training courses have been implemented with the aim of using the knowledge gained to strengthen institutional capacity, improve university curricula, and create a vibrant and economically sustainable waste economy in each of the partner countries.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the details of the Waste – Econ Program and the Regional Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program and to share information. Virginia Maclaren provided David Smith with copies of four student reports/theses on various waste management issues in Viet Nam and South East Asia. It was agreed to have a follow-up meeting in March/April 2005.

- ii. In January 2005, Regional Niagara provided review comments to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) on the draft Terms of Reference for the FCM intern work which will be undertaken in February 2005 in Tuy Hoa. The intern, in partnership with a staff member from Tuy Hoa, will research the waste collection and diversion practises in the Town of Tuy Hoa and prepare a written report. The findings of this report will be presented and discussed during the Second Technical Exchange Mission in Canada scheduled for June 2005.

6.0 PROJECTED ACTIVITIES

The following activities will be undertaken in the next six months:

- i. Second Technical Exchange Mission

The Second Technical Exchange Mission Plan will be prepared by Regional Niagara and Tuy Hoa, and reviewed and approved by FCM and ACVN.

- ii. Peer Review New Waste Disposal Site Design

Tuy Hoa will assemble available information pursuant to the *Check List of Information Relative to Design of New Waste Disposal Sites*.

Tuy Hoa will identify possible stakeholders of the proposed new Tuy Hoa waste disposal site and schedule a consultation session(s) with the stakeholders to provide input into the design considerations of the new site.

Regional Niagara and Tuy Hoa will prepare a draft check list document for the design of new waste disposal sites.

iii. Prepare Landfill Closure Plan for Existing Waste Disposal Site

Tuy Hoa will identify any waste disposal site closure regulations, legislation, guidelines, standards, requirements, requirements, etc. in Viet Nam for municipalities.

Tuy Hoa will assemble available information identified in the *Sample Tables of Contents for a Landfill Closure Plan*.

iv. Prepare Landfill Operations and Maintenance Manual for New Waste Disposal Site

Regional Niagara will forward Table of Contents from typical Landfill Operations and Maintenance Manuals to Tuy Hoa.

Appendix A

List of Question about Waste Management/Environmental Issues in the Town of Tuy Hoa prepared by Regional Niagara Delegation and the Answers prepared by the Town of Tuy Hoa's People's Committee

December 5, 2004

1. *How will residents and business people accept changes to the waste management system?*

It is believed that residents and business people will accept and consent to the work of environmental protection including changes to the waste management system.

2. *How is the existing waste management system financed or paid for (charges to residents, funds from Provincial and/or National Governments)?*

Because residents' conditions of living are still in difficulties, charges of waste collection service to residents and business people are low. So, in addition to charges to residents and business people, funds from the Province of Phu Yen are annually financed for the existing waste management system.

3. *What changes to the existing system financing will be necessary to accommodate improvements to the waste management system?*

There are not any changes yet.

4. *Does the Town of Tuy Hoa believe that it would be the good idea to designate one individual to be responsible for coordinating the Town's public awareness programs which includes dissemination of information to the school, business people, residents, women's union, and other organizations?*

The Town of Tuy Hoa believes in that.

5. *It is Regional Niagara's understanding that you wish to develop the tourism potential of the Town of Tuy Hoa. How will the Town of Tuy Hoa plan their waste management system (collection and disposal) to accommodate this new tourism development?*

- The Town of Tuy Hoa is implementing waste collection project in residential areas.
- To project the new landfill site in the North-West Town.

6. *How will the Town of Tuy Hoa protect the small entrepreneurs (including women) from being adversely affected (loss of jobs and income) from any changes to the waste management system?*
- To carry out dissemination activities for environmental protection regulations and to canvass people for environmental protection and hygiene practices.
 - To transfer the adversely affected small entrepreneurs to another business.
7. *Given that approximately 65% of the waste is currently being collected, will the Town of Tuy Hoa agree to collect 100% of the waste within 2 to 5 years?*

Approximately 70% of the waste is currently being collected in the Tuy Hoa's urban residential areas. The Town of Tuy Hoa will agree to collect 100% of the waste within 2 to 5 years.

8. *Does the Town of Tuy Hoa believe that stricter regulations must be passed to regulate how residents prepare and set out their waste?*

The Town of Tuy Hoa believes in that.

9. *How will the Town of Tuy Hoa train staff to enforce existing environmental protection regulations including littering?*

The Town of Tuy Hoa will carry out dissemination of information to each household and train better staff to enforce existing environmental protection regulations.

10. *Will the Town of Tuy Hoa be willing to support waste management with sufficient financing (i.e. provide more funds to improve waste collection, diversion and disposal)?*

The Town of Tuy Hoa will be willing to support that.

11. *What is the role of the Town of Tuy Hoa in the design and construction of the new landfill site?*

The role of the Town of Tuy Hoa in the design and construction of the new landfill site is:

- to select the location of the new landfill site with prescriptive standards.
- to select prestigious companies of consultancy, research and design.
- to canvass the community to give their consent for the design and construction of the new landfill site.
- to request partnership and help from foreign organizations.

12. *What measures will the Town of Tuy Hoa take to ensure that the new landfill site will be environmentally safe?*

The Town of Tuy Hoa will invest and construct an environmentally safe and hygienic new landfill site

13. *In the draft Project Proposal, it is noted that Regional Niagara will peer review the design of the new landfill site. What would the Town of Tuy Hoa like the Regional Niagara to do with respect to the site design?*

The Town of Tuy Hoa would like Regional Niagara to help modern techniques and increase the capacity of Tuy Hoa staff to address environmental/waste management challenges at the local level.

The Town of Tuy Hoa would like Regional Niagara to invest in proper equipments for waste collection and diversion, and waste disposal services.

14. *Is there any duplication of work between Niagara – Tuy Hoa Municipal Partnership Program and any other partnerships between the Town of Tuy Hoa, Provincial and National Government, and any other countries?*

There is not any duplication of work.

15. *It is the wish of FCM that an agreement on draft Project Proposal can be reached between Regional Niagara and the Town of Tuy Hoa at the conclusion of this mission. Does the Town of Tuy Hoa accept the draft Project Proposal? What changes does the Town of Tuy Hoa wish to make? Can the Town of Tuy Hoa sign the Project Proposal?*

The Town of Tuy Hoa accepts the draft Project Proposal.

However, the Town of Tuy Hoa wishes to make changes including:

-Because of the change of the Board of Tuy Hoa's Government, in order to provide an opportunity for the Tuy Hoa delegation to learn about Canadian Municipal Governance, and observe Regional Niagara practice and methods in the areas of waste collection and diversion, and waste disposal, the Town of Tuy Hoa requests a six-person delegation to attend the Second Technical Exchange Mission in Canada-June 2005 including:

- i. 01 (one) the senior leader of the Province of Phu Yen
- ii. 03 (three) the senior officials of the Town of Tuy Hoa
- iii. 01 (one) interpreter
